### **STEPHEN STILLS A SAMPLING OF HIS PERSONA**



Stephen Stills was born January 3, 1945 and is best known for his collaboration with David Crosby, Graham Nash (CSN) and on many occasions Neil Young.

But there is more to Stills...born and raised in a military family, he moved frequently living in Florida, Louisiana, Costa Rica and the Panama Canal Zone where he experienced different musical influences (i.e. blues, folk, Latin). He became an avid sailor

After dropping out of the University of Florida to pursue music, he went to NYC where he ended up in a 9-member vocal harmony group playing the famous Café AuGoGo. After this stint he formed *The Company* taking the group to Canada where he met Neil Young who was doing what he always wanted to do according to Stills: "...playing folk music in a rock band."

He failed an audition to become a *Monkee* so he moved to California where he formed the core of the *Buffalo Springfield*. It was in this group where he honed his guitar playing skills by experimenting – soaking strings in bar-b-que sauce among other things.

During the disintegration of *Springfield*, he hooked up with Nash and Crosby. Cass Elliot was instrumental in this meeting which was held at Joni Mitchell's house. This mega group is off again, on again. All 3 retain solo careers.

During one of his solos in France, he met and married Veronique Sanson who bore him a son, Chris. The marriage dissolved.

Stills was the first person to be inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame twice in the same night for his work with *Springfield* and *CSN*.

An avid political activist, he was a delegate to the Democratic National Convention; sang the National Anthem during the Stanley Cup series and survived prostate cancer.
