### **FROM STAFF GUITARIST TO HALL OF FAMER**

Joe South (Joseph Alfred Souter) was born in Atlanta, Georgia February 28, 1940. Reared in the housing projects to a poor but enthusiastic family, he began emulating his guitar playing father by standing on a

woodpile imagining he was entertaining an audience.

At an young age he landed an early morning show on an Atlanta country radio station. Interested in the technical side of music, he built a home-based station broadcasting a radius of over a mile.


In 1957 he joined a band and wrote the novelty hit *The Purple People Eater Meets the Witch Doctor*. His solo career was slow to move but he kept up with his songwriting. *Untie Me* which he wrote for the *Tams* went number 1 nationally and his career was on its way.

The route was slow but his guitar playing made him a valuable commodity for Simon & Garfunkel, Bob Dylan, Aretha Franklin, among others.

His career really took off in the late 60's when his songs hit the charts. Among them were *Don't It*

*Make You Wanna Go Home, Walk A Mile In My Shoes, Games People Play, Down In The Boondocks, Hush, Yo-Yo, I Never Promised You A Rose Garden, How Can I Unlove You, Fool Me* and other.

Honors he was awarded were Grammys, Gold Record Status, Song of the Year and he was inducted into the Georgia Music Hall of Fame as well as Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame.
