HE DANCED WITH THE STARS AND TAUGHT THEM

Arthur Murray "rumba-ed" with Eleanor Roosevelt, "dipped" with the Duke of Windsor, "jitterbugged" with John D. Rockefeller and "mambo-ed" with the Manassa Mauler, aka Jack Dempsey. Murray's dancing techniques (circa early 1920's) and dance studios still live on.

Born in Austria April 4, 1895, he emigrated with his mother when he was 2 years old. Shy and self-conscious about his tall lanky appearance, he sought his popular friend's help - Joe Feigenbaum taught him his first dance steps. He practiced, practiced, practiced by attending all the neighborhood weddings.

He won his first contest while in high school. The prize, a silver cup, was taken home by his partner making such an impression that he made sure **every** winner in **his** dance competitions took home a prize.

His first venture into teaching dance was through a mail order business...dance steps with footprint diagrams...500,000 dance courses were sold.



In 1925, he married his beloved dance partner, Kathryn. They opened their first studio shortly after their marriage. Success followed more and more studios were opened and both he

and his wife appeared on television. The Arthur Murray Dance Studio is the second oldest franchise following A&W Restaurants.
