...a month whose first day starts with deceit and ends by celebrating National Honesty Day but in-between...

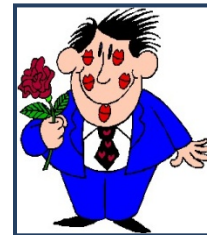
